The course aim is to provide an Intermediate workshop on the JCT 2016 family of contracts, specifically focusing on the Standard Building Contract with Quantities (SBC/Q), but other members of the JCT 2016 family will also be considered and discussed. At the end of the course, participants should be able to:

- Appreciate the structure and content of the JCT 2016 family of documents
- Be able to practically apply the various procedures under the contracts
- Properly manage a JCT 2016 contract
