Assessment

To be awarded the NCFE Level 2 Certificate in Common Health Conditions, learners must achieve a minimum of 15 credits:

- a total of 2 credits from the mandatory unit in Group A
- a minimum of 13 credits from the optional units in Group B

Assessment involves a blended delivery approach - This is a mixture of face-to-face and remote sessions with a qualified health and social care assessor.

Certification

Delegates will be awarded the NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Common Health Conditions.
