Course Overview

The purpose of this qualification is to increase learners' awareness and understanding of falls and their prevention, which will allow them to progress into or within employment in healthcare or social care settings.

Course Objectives

The objective of the qualification is to allow learners to gain knowledge and understanding of:

- the impact and consequences of a fall
- risks and hazards which contribute to falls
- reducing the risk of falls

The qualification also covers the importance of recording and reporting any incidence of falls to ensure that interventions can be put in place to reduce the risk and re-occurrence of falls.

This qualification is aimed at anyone working in a healthcare or social care environment, particularly those that support or have contact with older people who have an increased propensity to falls.

- 4. Managing falls



Assessment

To be awarded the Level 2 Certificate in Falls Prevention Awareness, learners are required to successfully complete 4 mandatory units.

Assessment involves a blended delivery approach - This is a mixture of face-to-face and remote sessions with a qualified health and social care assessor.

Delegates will be awarded the NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Falls Prevention Awareness.
