Assessment

To achieve the Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication in Health and Social Care, learners must complete all four mandatory units to achieve 15 credits.

Assessment involves a blended delivery approach - This is a mixture of face-to-face and remote sessions with a qualified health and social care assessor.

Delegates will be awarded the NCFE CACHE Level 2 Certificate in Understanding the Safe Handling of Medication in Health and Social Care.
