

# **CPCS Rough Terrain Forklift (A14)**

**Accreditation** CPCS

Course duration 2-4 Days depending on experience

Certificate valid for 2 years

## Who should attend

This course is aimed at people who require a formal qualification for operating a Rough Terrain Forklift.

Learners with limited or no experience of operating a Rough Terran Forklift will require a four-day novice course, whereas experienced operators can attend a shorter two-day experienced worker course.

## **Course information**

#### Course content

- Risks associated with guick hitch devices and how to use them safely
- Operating the machine to a minimum standard
- Fitting and operating ancillary equipment
- Siting the machine safely and efficiently
- Carrying out minor adjustments and routine servicing procedures
- Preparing the machine for travelling on the public highway
- The capabilities of each machine, its purpose and limitations
- All safety precautions necessary for the correct operation of the machine
- How diesel engines work and how various parts of the machine operate
- Which routine adjustments and servicing procedures are necessary, and how to carry them
  out.

## **Entry requirements**

Learners must have passed the Operatives Health, Safety and Environment Test within the last 2 years, prior to course start date.

Good understanding of spoken and written English.

#### **Assessment**

One-three days learning through a mix of classroom-based teaching and practical exercises, followed by one day assessment - CPCS technical tests.

## Certification

Learners will receive a Red CPCS Trained Operator Card on passing the CPCS technical tests, valid for two years.



After gaining on-site experience, you must complete an NVQ level 2 within two years to apply for the blue CPCS Competence Card which is renewable every five years.
